

HOW TO CONFIGURE E-MAIL (OUTLOOK EXPRESS)

First: Open *Outlook Express*. Click the Tools menu. Select Accounts. Click the Add button, and then select Mail.

1. You'll be asked for a Display Name. This should be the name you want displayed when you send e-mail.
2. Now, you'll need to enter your e-mail address. Your e-mail address is your user name appended with @lek.net (e.g., support@lek.net).
3. The following screen will ask you for the incoming and outgoing mail servers. The incoming mail server should be **pop3.lek.net**, and the outgoing server should be **smtp.lek.net** (see graphic below).
4. Finally, you'll be asked to enter your Account Name and Password. Your account name is the same as your email address.
